

4. A permanent Co-ordinating Committee will be established under the Control Council, composed of one representative of each of the three Commanders-in-Chief, not below the rank of General Officer or the equivalent.
5. The duties of the Co-ordinating Committee, acting on behalf of the Control Council, will include:-
- (a) the carrying out of the decisions of the Control Council;
 - (b) the day-to-day supervision and control of the activities of the German central administration and institutions;
 - (c) the co-ordination of current problems which call for uniform measures in all three zones;
 - (d) the preliminary examination and preparation for the Control Council of all questions submitted by individual Commanders-in-Chief.
6. (a) The Control staff will be organised in Divisions which will, so far as practicable, correspond functionally with the main branches of the German central administration;
- (b) At the head of each Division there will be three high-ranking officials, one from each Power. The duties of three heads of each Division, acting jointly, will include:-
- (i) acting as advisers to the Control Council;
 - (ii) serving as the channel for the transmission to the German central administration of the decisions of the Control Council conveyed to them through the Co-ordinating Committee;
 - (iii) supervising the action taken by the corresponding branches of the German central administration and institutions;
- (c) The three heads of a Division will be invited to take part in meetings of the Co-ordinating Committee at which matters affecting the work of their Division are on the agenda.
- (d) the staffs of the Divisions may include civilian as well as military personnel. They may also include nationals of other United Nations, appointed in their personal capacity.
- (e) The number, functions and internal organisation of the Divisions will be defined in a separate agreement between the Governments of the United Kingdom, the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
7. (a) An Inter-Allied Governing Authority (Komendatura) consisting of three Commandants, one from each Power, will be established to direct jointly the
