
Ottawa, 27th May, 1913.

Sir:-

I beg to draw your attention to Order-in-Council of the 11th March, by which two months leave of absence from duty on account of illness was granted Mr. W.E. Allen, a clerk in subdivision "A" of the Third Division in this Department.
