as regards the Michipicoten Reserve. On looking up my letter of the 10th. December last and enclosed draft of minutes of the conference held between our Ministers, I find that item No. 4, which deals with the reserves mentioned in your Order in Council of the 9th. October, 1914, also states that it is understood that Ontario will recognize the rights of any Indians resident at Michipicoten to lots which they may occupy. No mention of this is made in the Order in Council.
