THE PRIME MINISTER:

As directed by you, Mr. Measures telephoned to Rt. Hon. Malcolm MacDonald regarding the invitation to dine at Earns cliffe at 7.15 this evening.

Mr. MacDonald said that although it is not possible for Mr. Morrison to arrive in Ottawa before ten o'clock tonight, he would be delighted if the Prime Minister would dine with Miss MacDonald and himself. But, if the Prime Minister has any other commitment which would make this inconvenient, Mr. MacDonald would understand.
