(24) The electoral division of Redberry, bounded as fol-Redberry lows:

Commencing at the meridian between the fifth and sixth ranges west of the third meridian where it is intersected by the North Saskatchewan river; thence northerly along the said meridian between the fifth and sixth ranges to the northern boundary of the said province of Saskatchewan; thence westerly along the said northern boundary of the province of Saskatchewan to the meridian between the thirteenth and four-teenth ranges west of the third meridian; thence southerly along the said meridian between the thirteenth and four-teenth ranges to the North Saskatchewan river; thence along the said North Saskatchewan river down stream to the point of commencement.

(25) The electoral division of Battleford, bounded as fol-Battleford lows:

Commencing at the meridian between the thirteenth and fourteenth ranges west of the third meridian where it is intersected by the north boundary of the twenty-sixth township; thence northerly along the said meridian between the thirteenth and fourteenth ranges, to the northern boundary of the said province of Saskatchewan; thence westerly along the said northern boundary of the province of Saskatchewan to the western boundary of the said province of Saskatchewan; thence southerly along the said western boundary of the province of Saskatchewan to the north boundary of the twenty-sixth township; thence casterly along the said north boundary of the twenty-sixth townships to the point of commencement.

H IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:
