

BY-LAW NO. 162.

To equalize the valuations of Real and Personal Property
in the Assessment Rolls of the different Townships,
and Villages in the County of Elgin, for the year,
1867.

PASSED 20th June, 1867.

And whereas the Council of the County of Elgin, by virtue of the 72nd Sec. of the Act 29, 30th Vic., Chap. 53, have examined the Assessment Rolls of the different Townships and Villages in the County, for the preceding financial year, to ascertain whether the valuation made by the Assessors for the current year bears a just relation to the valuation so made in all such Townships and Villages.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the County of Elgin, by virtue of the authority aforesaid,

That the following Schedule of valuation be the equalized valuation of Real and Personal Property, in the several Townships and Villages in the County of Elgin, for the year 1867.
