" *Dear Sir,*

" In regard to the matter of Rates for Garantie of the  
" members of your Association. We beg to say :

" Considering the safeguards adopted by your society, and  
" the benefits generally of such. We will accept from all  
" members, of the association, as per certificate to be finished,  
" that he is a member of this association, a rate of sixty-five  
" cents per hundred dollars, for the first year, and fifty cents,  
" for subsequent years, when the usefulness of the associa-  
" tion will have been established. It is of course on the  
" understanding that we got all your members, and this rate  
" will not apply to those outside the association. We would  
" also suggest that all the Bonds be made to expire upon  
" a given date, to be agreed upon by yourselves, tho this is  
" of no importance to us. Trusting this will be satisfactory.
