LV. And be it further enacted, That when any article or articles shall be Seized articles to be seized for a breach of the Revenue Laws of this Province, it shall be the duty of the Treasurer or Deputy Treasurer to make application to any one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in the County where such articles were seized, to nominate two persons to appraise the articles so seized, whose valuation shall be accepted as the true value thereof, the expense attending such valuation to be deducted from the proceeds of the seizure.

LVI. And be it further enacted, That all articles which shall have been seized, Articles seized to be sold at public condemned and forfeited under and by virtue of this Act, shall under the direc- auction. tion of the Treasurer or Deputy Treasurer at the port or place where such articles shall have been so seized, condemned and forfeited, be sold by public auction to the highest bidder, and the proceeds of such sales disposed of as is provided in and by this Act.

LVII. And be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the Province and the Oaths may be ad-Deputy Treasurers respectively are hereby authorized and empowered to admi- Treasurer or nister all the oaths required to be made and taken for carrying the provisions of Deputies. this or any other Act relating to the Revenue of the Province into effect; and every person who shall be convicted of making a false oath to any of the particulars required of him to be sworn to, shall be liable to all the pains and penalties to which persons are liable for wilful and corrupt perjury.

LVIII. And be it further enacted, That the Clerk in the Office of the Pro- Treasurer's Clerk vincial Treasury at the City of Saint John appointed or to be appointed by the may administer of saint. Treasurer of the Province, while in such office, is hereby empowered to administer all oaths required to be administered by the Treasurer of the Province upon entries, manifests or other proceedings in the said office, in like manner as the Treasurer of the Province is authorized to administer the same; and any person who shall make a false oath before such Clerk in such office shall be deemed guilty of perjury, and liable to the pains and penalties of the same : provided always, that the Treasurer of the Province shall first publish in the Royal Clerk's name to be Gazette the name of such Clerk.

LIX. And be it further enacted, That the liability of any article or articles to Liability of articles seizure under and by virtue of this or any other Act relating to Revenue, to seizure limited to two years from shall be and continue for the term of two years from the time the same are im- importation. ported or brought into the Province and no longer.

LX. And be it further enacted, That the right of recovering any of the duties, Recovery of duties, penalties and forfeitures imposed, inflicted or incurred under the provisions of Acts, reserved. any former Act or Acts relating to Revenue, and all securities taken by virtue of the same, are hereby expressly saved.

LXI. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for all Deputy The Deputy Trea-Treasurers, except the Deputy Treasurer for the Port of Saint John, in case of surers may provide sickness or necessary absence of either of them, to appoint a fit person for them content of their duties in case of sickness, &c. respectively, to attend to the duties of their respective offices during their sickness or necessary absence, and for the conduct of such person the said Deputy Treasurer and their respective sureties shall be responsible.

LXII. And be it further enacted, That at the Ports or Districts of Saint John, Period of payment Saint Andrew's, Saint Stephen's, Fredericton, and Woodstock, the duties imposed of duties on imporon goods, wares, and merchandize, by any Law or Laws relating to Revenue in St. Andrews, St. this Province, shall be paid at the time of importation, or if warehoused under the ton and Woodstock. provisions of this or any Act of the Imperial Parliament, prior to removal from such Warehouse, otherwise than for exportation or removal from one Warehouse to another within this Province.
