Duties to be paid by Importers.

Timber, Lumber,

All which Duties shall be paid by the Importer or Importers of such articles to the Collector or Sub-Collectors of Her Majesty's Customs, and shall be collected and secured by the means, and under the regulations and penalties, and in the way and manner, hereinafter provided.

II.-And be it further enacted, that upon the entry of any Timber, &c. previous to en-try to be measured as required by Law. be hereafter imported into this Island or its Dependencies, the Master or Commander of the Vessel in which such Timber, Lumber, or Shin-gles may have been imported, shall, before such Vessel shall be cleared at the Customs, produce to the Collector or Sub-Collectors, respectively, a certificate from some one of the Sworn Surveyors of
