his Hand and Seal of Office: Provided, that there be no legal objection to the said Guardians, in consequence of either the Laws of Great Britain or this Island; and such Guardians when so appointed, Powers of Guarshall be vested with the like powers and authority as Guardians are in England and this Island, or as if they had been appointed by the Chancellor of this Island.

CAP. XVI.
