



Infectious Diseases—Distribute by means of a spray freely over the sick room a weak solution (about 1 oz. fluid to 5 pints water). Bed vessels and other utensils should be thoroughly cleansed with a solution of about 1 part to 10.

All Infected Linen and Clothing should be washed in a solution (1 part in 100), and this can be done without fear of injury to the most delicate fabrics, and with the confident expectation of rendering them thoroughly aseptic.

A Wise Precaution in case of infectious disease is to shut off the sick room by means of a sheet saturated with a solution of about 1 part in 80.

For the Bath-If sufficient fluid to cloud the water be added the effect on the body will be found most exhilarating and re-
