PROTOCOL PUT ASIDE PENDING OUTCOME OF POUCHARFERS. GENEVA, Sept. 13.

The peace protocol of 1924 is not to be further dealt with at the present session of the League of Nations pending the outcome of the pourcharfers between Germany and the Allies.

RAMSAY MACDONALD WILL NOT SPEAK IN CANADA. LONDON, Sept. 13.

On account of the Canadian General elections being scheduled for October 29, Ramsay MacDonald, former Premier of Great Britain, has cancelled his fall speaking tour in Canada.

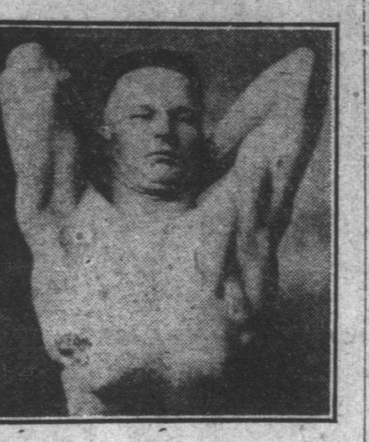
Motor Smashups
