This spring, for the first time in the history of the seal fishery, airplanes have reconsidered the Arctic flocks of the east coast, and have discovered the location of the main herd. The venture was carried out by Major Cotton in a Martinside machine, and by Capt. Bennett in a Westland. Among those present when the great aggregation of seals was sighted was the ubiquitous movie man, who took thousands of feet of film pictures. The aviators boarded some of the Newfoundland steam sealing fleet, and found that most of the ships were doing well.
