

CANADA UNALARMED

Claim Proposed Limit On Immigrations Into U.S. Would Aid Dominion.

Canadian Press Despatch. Ottawa, Dec. 4.—The recommenda ion of U. S. Secretary of Labor Davis in his annual report, that uota restrictions be placed on citiens of Canada desiring to enter the American republic, is not viewed with perceptible alarm here.

While the department of immigra-

ion and colonization was quite reluctant today to discuss the question, it has been intimated that the enactment of any legisaltion by congress that prevented a large exodus the United States would probably be to the benefit of Canada as whole, and result in keeping more of our citizens in this country. A further recommendation of Secretary Davis for administrative restriction of all immigration unde riction of all immigration under visiting legal limits in times of un-mployment is evidently along the nes of the present Canadian immi-ration act on this point, which makes provision for the passing of no order-in-council at any time reg-lating the influx of United States and other citizens, conditional on op-ortunities for employment, and conomic and industrial conditions.
