**FALL FROM APPLE TREE FATAL**

The death occurred on Wednesday afternoon at the family residence, lot 8, con. 13, Metcalfe, of James Henry Case, a well-known and highly respected farmer, in his 64th year. Mr. Case suffered a fall about four weeks ago from an apple tree, when the limb broke on which he was standing while picking apples, dislocating his shoulder and hurting his spine, from which he never recovered. Mr. Case was born near Lapeer, Mich., and came to this country with his parents when about four years of age, settling in Carleton Place, where he resided until about seven years ago, when he removed to Metcalfe township. Besides his widow he is survived by three sons and four daughters. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. M. Parr, pastor of the Appin Methodist church, and interment was made in the Strathroy cemetery.
