The Senate was then adjourned during pleasure and again put into a Committee of the Whole on the said Bill.

(In the Committee.)

Clause 2 being again considered, it was moved to amend it, as follows :---

"Strike out all of that part of Section 2 following the first paragraph thereof." The question being put on the said amendment, the Committee divided, as follows:--`

So it was resolved in the affirmative. After a while the Chairman left the Chair.

The Senate was resumed.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate was adjourned during pleasure, and put into a Committee of the Whole on the Bill 99, "An Act to amend The Exchequer Court Act."

(In the Committee.)

After some time the Senate was resumed, and

The Honourable Mr. Daniel, from the said Committee, reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the said Bill be placed on the Orders of the Day for a Third Reading to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate proceeded to the consideration of the Sixth Report of the Standing Committee on Internal Economy and Contingent Accounts.

The said Report was adopted.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate proceeded to the consideration of the Seventh Report of the Standing Committee on Internal Economy and Contingent Accounts.

The said Report was adopted.

The Senate adjourned.
