Donation of Medals by the Lieutenant-Governor

"The offer of the Lieutenant-Governor to donate medals to the Faculty was then considered. It was moved by the Dean, seconded by Professor Corbett and resolved that the Lieutenant-Governor be asked to donate a silver medal for the final examination in Roman Law. The question of the bronze medal was then discussed. It was moved by the Dean, seconded by Professor Chipman and resolved that the bronze medal be awarded for the course in Obligations in First Year."
