Sir:-

I note that the provisional Regulations for the C.O.T.C. provide under Sections 28-30 that officers of the Permanent Active Militia may be appointed as Adjutants to contingents. I suggest that we comment upon the great desirability of this regulation especially.

If these regulations are confirmed, I beg that application may be made for the appointment of such an officer to this unit.

Nearly all the officers of this contingent are students, and they have no time to carry out their ~~duties~~ *duties of adjutants*, whilst at the same time prosecuting their ordinary studies.

If such an appointment were made it would allow me to devote time to the development of the corps, which now I have to use in carrying out the duties of the adjutant.
