

The Board has to report the following changes during the year :—

In January, the Congregation of Bourg Louis was annexed to the Mission of Vulcartier, and placed under the charge of the Rev. A. A. von Iffland, and the Rev. J. G. Maccaether in Deacon's orders was appointed his assistant. Mr. Maccaether has recently resigned his position. In September Mr. John Walters, a Student of St. Augustine's Missionary College at Canterbury, was admitted to the Order of Deacons, and proceeded immediately after his Ordination to the Magdalene Islands, to the charge of which Mission recently assumed by the Board, he had been previously appointed by the Bishop with the concurrence of the Board.

In May, the Rev. R. C. Tambs, was appointed to the office of Travelling Missionary, and had charge of the Quarantine Station at Grosse Isle during the summer months. He is at present engaged in affording occasional services to Congregations in the Eastern Townships.

The Treasurer reports, that the Funds at the disposal of the Board are sufficient to enable it to make up the incomes of all the Clergy in Priest's Orders to \$600, and to add \$50 to the income of each Deacon for the year 1866.

The Reports which have been obtained from the Clergy paid through the Board are annexed, and will enable the Church Society to form some opinion as to the condition and prospects of her Missions.
