Memorable Hereford Sale

The sale of Mr. W. T. McCarty's Hereford cattle, Ind. choice Hereford cattle, was the highest average in North America during the past thirteen years. The gross total for the 75 head was \$40,010, the 49 cows sold at an average of \$400 per head, and the 27 bulls at \$242.33 per head. These two bulls reached the top figure, \$2500, one going to the State of Nebraska; the other to the State of Missouri. The entry of the cows into the arena increased the vim of the animated crowd. The critical eyes of the Canadians selected the two top notches: Simon Downie and Frank Sherwood, each paying \$1925 for Sallie and \$700 for Primrose. Manitoba was not to be outdone by the western rival. J. A. Chapman of Brandon came to the front, purchasing Gay Lass V for \$1100, and Miss Armour for \$775. Ocala was purchased by Ontario, L. O. Clifford, Oshawa, buying Florida Yates for \$1100. A change, less than a decade ago the highest prices paid for pedigree stock at Ontario sales were offered by American buyers.
