

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-484.

An Act for the relief of Lucien Carbonneau.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Lucien Carbonneau, domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, has by his petition alleged that on the thirty-first day of August, A.D. 1953, at the said city, he and Pierrette Coallier were married; and whereas by his petition he has prayed that, on the ground of her adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of his petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
