In p. 30 insert the following:—A line of stages three times a week is now established between Port St. Francis and Sherbrooke, to perform the distance, 85 miles, in the course of the day. The steam-boats leave Quebec and Montreal every evening and meet at Port St. Francis about six or seven o'clock the following morning, landing the passengers for the Eastern Townships, and on the alternate days the stages are in readiness to convey them to Sherbrooke. From Quebec or Montreal, therefore, the whole distance is performed in less than twenty-four hours, the night being passed on board the steam-boat. The line of stages is continued on through Stanstead to Burlington on Lake Champlain, and direct communication thus had with New York and Boston.
