TOWN IN WALES

Community Springs Up On An Arid Waste—Pipe Line From Swansea.

London, March 5.—(A. P. by Mail).—Renewed attention has just been called to the romantic story of the great industrial development in South Wales, a land of romance in industry, by the building of a new 27,000,000 "town" near Swansea with home for a population of 1,500 workers.

The site of the new enterprise for the refining of oil brought here from the Persia gulf is between Neath and Swansea, where vast oil refineries have been constructed.

There within a boundary wall fifteen miles in circumference a great oil company has built a new town, including stores, cantens, a post office and, in fact, almost every adjunct for the comfort and convenience of the workers and their families who are to inhabit the place.

Stupendous Undertaking
The undertaking is described as among the largest and most ambitious ever known in South Wales, where the great advances in industry have yielded more fortunes than in any other part of the United Kingdom.

The town sprang into existence as if by a magician's wand on an arid waste, lying in a hollow basin surrounded by small hills. It is about 400 acres in ex-

tent and about five miles from Swansea. Towering tanks, each capable of holding 1,000,000 gallons of oil, now rear their heads above the village, and at Swansea great docks and reservoirs have been constructed to receive the ships with their oil from the Peruvian fields and other oil-bearing regions of the Near East.

As received, the oil will be pumped through pipes from Swansea through the new refining town, and after refinement will be returned over the same route to Swansea for worldwide distribution.

This inaugurates an industry in South Wales, which it is predicted will add new wealth to that already prosperous region.

TAX EXEMPTION
STARTS BUILDING
IN NEW YORK

New York, March 21.—The first pronounced boom in home building here since the war was shown today in a compilation of building statistics for the last two weeks. Plans for new buildings filed during this period were 61 per cent. greater than in the corresponding period last year.

A recent municipal by-law provides for a maximum tax exemption of \$5,000 annually for ten years on all dwellings, the construction of which is begun before April 1, 1922. The boom is attributed to the new exemption law by city officials.
