

**GAVE LIFE TO
SAVE MOTHER
AND HER CHILD**

**Heroic Watchman Suffocated
in New York Fire—Shouted
Directions Before Death.**

New York, Sept. 25—Overcome by smoke while attempting to rescue a woman and her little child from a fire that

destroyed a four-story building in Brooklyn, the night watchman, whose last name is Pashatsky, was suffocated to death. Before he succumbed, however, he shouted directions that enabled the woman to carry her child to safety. The woman, who was sweeping a tailor shop on the third floor, said the fire was started by an oil-soaked paper ball which she saw hurled through an open window. Three firemen were overcome by smoke trying to rescue the watchman.

MAN WAS TARRED.

Unusual Case Heard by Cornwall Magistrate.

Cornwall, Sept. 25—Four young men from Marlinton, Wm. Merpaw, Wm. Paradis or Allinet, Jos. Ladouceur and George Flaro, appeared in the police court here on a charge of assaulting Frank Tyo on the night of August 29. The case was heard by Deputy Police Magistrate C. H. Cline.

The assault was the result of the refusal of Tyo to obey a request made by some of the defendants to leave the town. His house had been stoned and stale eggs were thrown at him. As he still remained in the locality the four men visited Tyo's house, took him outside, and Ladouceur put hot tar in his hair, on his face, neck and hands, while the other three held the victim. The defence, while admitting applying the tar, denied that it was hot. The magistrate said that it was inconceivable that such a state of affairs as shown



nesses being unable to sign their names would not be so prevalent, as was disclosed in the case before the bench. The young men, whom he likened to a self-appointed vigilance committee, were not justified in taking the action they had, and he felt that there was something more in the motive than a desire to change the conduct of the complainant. He therefore found all four guilty of assault and imposed a fine of \$15 in each case, in default of which they were to be sent to jail for fifteen days at hard labor.
