It may be that the city and county will be divided into three ridings which would probably be the most convenient arrangement. While an election is in view it would be a very wise thing for the conservatives of St. John city and county to be looking about them for the purpose of ascertaining what available men they possess to run as candidates at the next election. It will not do to postpone the selection of the candidates to the last moment, because there will then be no time for them to make a thorough canvass or to become acquainted with the people. In the meantime there is a general demand for a convention of the Conservative party to be held in the autumn.


