

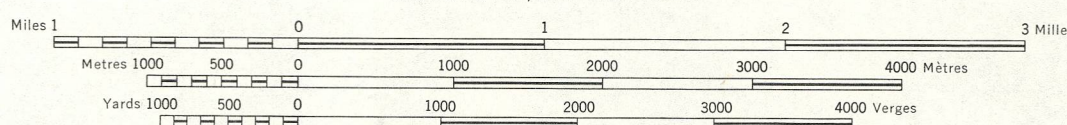

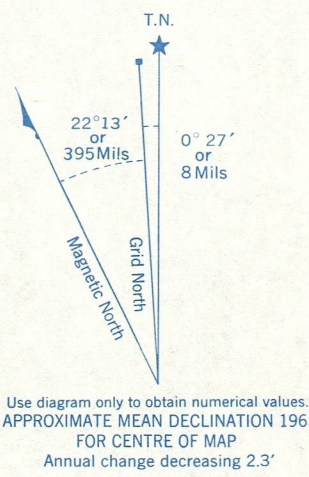

20T	MF

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES	
EXAMPLE: LIGHTHOUSE	
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point.	50
Estimate tenths of a square from this line outward to point.	6
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point.	506
Estimate tenths of a square from this line upward to point.	25
MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	506259
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
