8. In sub-section five of section nineteen of the said Act, the words in the eighth line "penalty of forty cents," shall be altered so as to read "penalty of ten cents, to be paid to the Inspector by the possessor or owner of such flour or meal,"

9. All that portion of the twentieth section of the said Act, after the words "secured by nails," in the thirteenth line, is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor, "and the tare of the barrel shall not be less than twenty pounds, under a penalty of ten cents for each cask of flour offered for sale or exported, which shall not be one of the foregoing description of barrels or half barrels, such penalty to be incurred by the person offering such cask for sale or exporting it."

Filling up

10. All that portion of the twenty third section of said Act, after the words "required by this Act," in the sixth line thereof, is repealed, and the following words shall be inserted in lieu thereof, "and shall fill up each barrel so that it shall contain the weight required by this Act, and shall charge such person the cost of such examination and refilling; which however shall not exceed ten cents for each barrel."

11. The second sub-section of the twenty-third section of the said Act is hereby repealed.

12. The twenty-eighth section of the said Act is hereby repealed. 20

13. All the words in section twenty-nine of the said Act, after the words "deficient in weight" in the seventh line, are hereby repealed.

14. Instead of the penalty of four dollars per barrel imposed by the thirtieth section of the said Act, it is enacted that the penalty shall be twenty-five cents per barrel. 25
