

An Act respecting the National Sanitarium Association.

WHEREAS the National Sanitarium Association has, by its ^{Preamble.} petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The National Sanitarium Association, incorporated by chapter 52 of the statutes of 1896, may from time to time ^{Borrowing powers.} borrow money upon the credit and for the purposes of the said Association, and may mortgage, hypothecate or pledge the real property of the said Association as security for the sums borrowed and interest; and by-laws may from time to time be made as provided by the said Act for the said purposes, but no person advancing money to the said Association shall ^{1896, c. 52.} be bound to see to the due application of the same or be answerable for any misapplication thereof.

2. In addition to the trustees appointed or to be appointed ^{Trustees.} as provided by the said Act, other trustees may be appointed from time to time for limited terms of service to represent ²⁰ municipalities granting financial assistance to the said Association, and by-laws may be made from time to time as provided by the said Act for determining and regulating the number, qualifications, mode of appointment and terms of service of such trustees.
