They also confirmed that prince Charles and Princess Diana will be in Edmonton for the opening ceremonies and reviewed the steps being taken to reduce their \$1.9 million funding shortfall.

The nations who have con-

firmed their participation in the games include Cuba, Bulgaria, and Great Britain. The only major athletic powers who will not be attending at this point are East and West Germany.

Iraq reversed their position from last January and will be sending a team despite their

political situation. Vietnam will also be sending a small contingent for the first time in many years. And Doonsbury fans can get ready to cheer Vietnam's favorite UN ally, Benin.

The total number of athletes and officials committed to be in Edmonton now stands at 3,700.

Universiade '83 President Ed Semerau announced that the Federal government has allocated \$481,000 to the NEED program, \$463,943 of which will go toward the games. The rest will be used by Sports Canada to prepare a book on organizing other multi-sport events, based on the organization of the Edmonton Cames of the Edmonton Games.

The Department of Communications have confirmed they

will donate \$400,000 to the games. Zemerau said games organizers are approaching Secretary of State Serge Joyal for \$300,000 to be tied into Canada Day celebrations.


