employed for some time past
in securing their crops and
others out on hunting expedi-
tions I have delayed
calling a Council the more
so as I am anxious to have a
general attendance - the harvest
season having nearly closed;
I have appointed the 9th Instant
for a general Council; and
as soon as I can collect the
sentiments of the several tribes
relative to the important com-
munication that it is my
duty to explain to them, I will
again do myself the pleasure
of addressing you -
