Whereas His Ex^{ty} In^o Montgomery Esq^r Captain Gen^l and Govern^r in Chief of the Provinces of New York New Jersey &c Hath on Request of the Sachims of the Six Nations consented that Lawrence Claese the Interpreter do go wth them to Marke out the Land w^{ch} they have in their publick Propositions given and granted to his Majesty King George the Second, the said Interpreter appearing before this Board Desires to have Instructions how to behave himselfe in this Affair which is orderd accordingly

Instructions for M^r Lawrence Claese the Interpreter

Whereas His Ex^{ty} In^o Montgomery Esq^r Captain Gen^l and Govern^r in Chief of the Provinces of New York New Jersey &c Hath consented to the Sachims of the Six Nations ^{that you} to go up in company wth them to Marke out w^{ch} them the Land at Oswego w^{ch} they have in their Publick Propositions Given and granted

Granted to his Majesty King George the Second for the use of his Majesty's Garrison posted at Oswego, YOU are therefore hereby required & Commanded forthwith to go up in company wth the Sachims accompanied wth one able man, and use your utmost Endeavour wth y^e Sachims to get Marked out by them as Large a Tract of Land at Oswego as possible you far and be Present at the said Marking or Laying out of the said Land, taking Speciall Notice at what place the said Land begins, what Course it runs into the Woods and how far from a Creek or River framing them and as near as you can how many yards or what Distance it runs from the place they stop, Noting the same down in Writing, and Describing the said Tract of Land as well as you are able, and Deliver it on your Return unto us under your hands that we may Transmitt the same unto his said Ex^{ty} our Gov^r. Given under our hands this 8th day of October in the Second year of His Majesties Reign Anno Dom^o 1720
