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(c) Every delegation should have several preliminary meetings for prayer before leaving school.

The following daily program will be carried out:

- (a) Bible Study or Mission Study.
- (b) School Association Conference. Here will be discussed the methods which have been found successful in the different schools in promoting Christian work. This will be in general charge of Francis P. Miller.
- (c) Interview Period.
- (d) Platform Meeting.

The afternoons will be given over to athletics and other forms of outdoor recreation, directed by a special committee on preparatory school athletics. Opportunity is also offered for participation in the regular tournaments and contests.

- (e) Life Work Address on Round Top.
- (f) Camp Fire or Platform Meetings.

CONFERENCE OF MASTERS

Each day at 4:30 masters from schools and others in close touch with religious work among boys will meet to discuss the general subject, "The Voluntary Religious Life of Boys."

The following topics will be the center of informal discussions:

- (a) The Importance of Spontaneity and Initiative in the Religion of Youth.
- (b) To what Extent may the Ordinary Boy be developed in Christian Leadership.
- (c) Cultivation of the Private Devotional Life of Boys.
- (d) The Relation to the Church during School Days.
- (e) Voluntary Religious Meetings and Campaigns.
- (f) The Way a Master Can and Cannot Help.

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
