

Under the heading of dairy produce, the prices of milk, wholesale at Montreal, creamery butter, dairy butter, cheese and storage eggs are included. <sup>are</sup> These commodities as a whole approximately thirty-three per cent higher than they were in the decade 1890-1899 and nearly fifty per cent higher than they were in 1896 and 1907, although they were somewhat lower in 1909 than in 1908.

In fish products, canned salmon shows a rise of 50 per cent and salmon trout and whitefish about the same. Groceries in general have increased 25 per cent since 1896.
