Attached is the memorandum concerning which Mr. Preston wished to speak with you. I have given Mr. Preston your message to the effect that it would be well for him to consult Mr. Robb but it seems that Mr. Robb has already told him that he can do nothing because the proposals relate also to Departments other than the Department of Trade and Commerce. I imagine Mr. Preston feels that the Government is not taking very seriously this proposal. Possibly you do not wish to have that impression conveyed. McG.
