

sent you upon receipt of a requisition from you for the same, should you find that the supply in the possession of your predecessors is insufficient in any respect.

At the end of each Quarter you should forward to the Department an account for the Commission due you on collections and distributions, also for any necessary disbursements on account of Postage, &c. that you may have had to make in connection with the business of your Agency.

You will understand that no orders given to Store-keepers by Chiefs or other Indians are to be recognized by you in connection with the payment of interest
