Sir,-

I beg to enclose herewith a list of clothing required for the various Bands of Indians in the Pas Agency, and would ask you to supply the same.

The quality of this clothing should be equal to that supplied last spring for the Indians of Treaty 10.

Each lot should be packed separately and marked with the name of the Band for which it is intended, the whole to be shipped to the Indian Agent, The Pas, via Hudson Bay Junction, if the Canadian Northern Ry. Co. will accept freight for delivery to The Pas. If not, you will please ship via Prince Albert. In any case you will kindly prepay freight charges and add the same to your account, attaching receipted freight bills.

I also enclose a list of clothing required for the Grand Rapids (Sask) Band which is now attached to the Norway House Agency. Please ship the same to your officer at that point with instructions to deliver the same to Mr. Agent Calverley at the approaching annuity payments.

Your account for the Pas Agency should be sent in triplicate to Mr. Agent Fisher, The Pas, and that for the Grand Rapids lot to Mr. Agent Calverley.
