 tents, blankets, provisions and cook for their party.

Additional charge for man to take full responsibility
 of transportation and control of the Indians \$150

Man in control of Indians to return with them
 from Martens Falls.

Martens Falls to Albany

(The Manager at Albany to be instructed
 that in as far as possible, and provided
 it can be done without detriment to the
 Company's interests, the boat from Albany
 to Attawapiskat is not to be crowded with
 natives as heretofore.)

Albany to Attawapiskat and return, allowing three
 days at Attawapiskat

175 - 100

Any further delay at Attawapiskat

15 per day

For board, etc. incurred at Attawapiskat
 while waiting for the "Inenew" to be charged
 according to services rendered.

Albany to Moose, by "Inenew" via Charlton
