Dear Sir-

In reply to your communication of the 22nd Instant, regarding the Gore Lot in rear of Lot 20, Con 1, Anderson, I regret very much that there has been delay in this matter caused by the failure of the local Agent to furnish the necessary information to enable the Department to place a value on the land and determine whether Mr. White was entitled to purchase.

On the 23rd Instant, Mr. Agent Adams was instructed to visit the locality and ascertain and report as to value and occupation of the Gore Lot.

The Department expects the requisite information from the local Agent at an early date, when the question of disposition of the land to Mr. White will receive immediate attention.
