Sir,-

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I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant enclosing a communication from Rev. Father Renaude nominating Miss Catherine Hinteul for the position of teacher of the Whitefish Lake School.

In reply I beg to say that when the Department offered a salary of \$450.00 per annum for this school it was upon condition that a qualified teacher would be obtained. As Miss Hinteul does hold these qualifications, the Department is only prepared to engage her temporarily, her retention to be dependent upon the success with which she works. You will be good enough to inform Father Renaude accordingly and draw his attention to the fact that the condition laid down by the Department has not been observed. The salary will be \$450.00 per annum. Please advise when Miss Hinteul takes charge.
