Ottawa, June 22, 1915.


Sir,-

In connection with applications received for fishing licenses, the Deputy Minister of Game and Fisheries for Ontario has asked to be supplied with a chart indicating what waters are looked upon by Indians as their fishing grounds, so that whenever applications are received his Department may be in a position to know whether any Indians are likely to be affected if the application should be granted.

To permit of this request being complied with as far as possible, I am sending you a section of map of Ontario in order that you may mark thereon the fishing grounds claimed by the Indians of your agency, and which have been occupied or used by them for any considerable time past.

When the required information is indicated on the map it should be returned to the Department with any remarks you may desire to make in regard thereto.
