Ottawa, 5th December 1917.

In reply to your letter of the 27th ultimo I have to say that it is not apparent that any damage will be done to the Magnettawan Indian reserve by allowing a telephone line to be constructed as desired by the Canadian Pacific Railway to their pumphouse; you may accordingly inform the officers interested that they may put up the necessary poles.


