----- The Prosecutor declines to re-examine.

---- BY PRESIDENT :-

I suppose a lot depends on how much is consumed?

A\_ Yes, sir.

----- In the opinion of the Court, it is not necessary to comply with RP 83 (B).

----- The witness withdraws.
