at Camp Borden, Ontario, on the 3rd October, 1944, after having been warned to proceed on Special Duty, with intent to avoid so proceeding, absented himself without leave from No. 1 C.A.C.T.S.R., C.A. from 0600 hours on the 3rd October, 1944 until he surrendered himself to the Military Authorities at Camp Borden, Ontario at 0530 hours on the 21st November, 1944 wearing Military Uniform.
