- A- I was pretty sure it was locked, sir.
- Q- You are certain that the door was locked where the safe is kept on every occasion you left there on that weekend?
- A- I do not recall, sir.
- Q- How many times were you in or through my office between 1130 hours and 1150 hours on 5 Jan?

Gross-examined by the accused :-

It was necessary. In the room where the safe was kept, for my use it was necessary. I know that there was a loaded automatic hanging in a holster from a clothes rack they were kept. I had a key to the room where I kept the safe. I did not touch the safe and am unable to say whether or not it was locked. My duties do not require me to go to it for any reason. I did not have a key to the cash box nor did I know where it was kept. No unauthorized persons were in the room to it. There was no evidence of anyone having been in the room on each occasion that I returned was kept. The premises I looked the room in which the safe I went to the South End Theatre. Whenever I left Sunday night between 1830 hours and 2215 hours when H.A.P. to listen to the hockey game and again on 2130 hours and 2230 hours when I went to the my meals and a period on Saturday night between Pay Office during the weekend with the exception of the times when I went to the washroom, went for door from Lieut. MacAllister's office to the safe was kept but had no other keys either to the outside, nor to the general office. I was in the alone on duty. I had a key to the room where the end at noon on Saturday 6 Jan 45 and I was left Tpr. Cameron and Tpr. Burgess left for short week-leave at noon on 5 Jan 45. G.M.S. MacGowan, Cpl. Whitebread and Tpr. DeBruyne left on weekend, the whole weekend. Lieut. MacAllister, Sgt. Greer, Friday morning 5 Jan 45 and remained on duty over I reported back for duty from New Year's leave on where the safe is kept, off the Paymaster's office. Office, T. & S. Wing, A-33 C.A.C.T.E., C.A., since April, 1944, and have been quartered in the room
