

The accused La Place entered shortly before 2000 hrs. This was just before the lights came on. I saw the accused Sullivan place the cup with the rum by his bed at 1830 hrs and shortly after eight I saw him pour the rum from the cup into the bottle, he put the bottle under his coat and left the building. Mrs Shaw and I were together in the sigs room when Mrs Laplace entered. We had candle light in the room before the lights came on.

### The Court.

The bottle the accused Sullivan had was a Squash bottle. The bottle was approx  $\frac{3}{4}$  full when he produced it from under the bed. I cannot remember the light schedule now for Feb. I saw the accused <sup>La Place</sup> on supper parade and again when he entered the sigs room. I would only take a couple of minutes to walk from the bullets of La Place to that of Sgt Carbone. It would take <sup>3-4</sup> minutes to walk from the sigs room to ~~the~~ Sgt Carbone. Mrs Sullivan had on battle dress but I cannot recall his exact dress at that time. He was wearing a moustache at the time. When the accused Sullivan first left the sigs room at approx 1845 he stated he was going for a beer. I have known the accused Sullivan for approx 5 years and the accused La Place for approx 67 months.
