Made and ordained in Adjourned Quarter Sessions, May 14th, 1817—revised and amended in Adjourned General Quarter Sessions, June 21st, 1823.

BREAD.

NO person or persons to sell or bake Bread or Biscuit for sale, without having previously obtained a Licence, and entered into Recognizance before the Clerk of the Peace, with two sufficient Sureties, in the sum of Twenty Pounds, to sell the same in conformity to the Assize, to be published monthly, by order of the Magistrates; and also, during the continuance of such Licence, to bake, and have daily for sale, a reasonable supply of Bread.
