HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

A NY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, ex-cepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homestcaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of are, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

or are acres, more or less. Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the dis-trict in which the landis situate. Entry by proxy may, however, be made on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, horther or sister of an intending homesteader.

The homesteader is required to perform the homestead conditions under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months' resi-dence unon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(3)—If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homesteader seedes upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for, the requirements as to resi-dence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or residue other

(3) If the settler has his per-manent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicin-ity of his homestead, the require-ments as to residence may be sat-isfied by residence upon the said hard. land
