ed by His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of this Province, authorized to execute the Commission of the Governor thereof, by and with the advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "*An Act to make temporary provision for the Government of Lower Canada*;"—And it is hereby Enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person administering the Government of this Province, by a Warrant or Warrants under his hand from time to time, or at any one time to authorize and direct the issue and payment, for the discharge and repayment of the advances aforesaid, to such person or persons as may be named in the said Warrants, out of any monies in the hands of the Receiver General, not otherwise specially appropriated and with preference to all other expenditure whatever, of such sum or sums as shall in the whole be equivalent at the current rate or rates of Exchange for Bills on Her Majesty's Treasury in London, which shall prevail in this Province, at the time or times of payment, to the before mentioned sum of one hundred thousand, one hundred and seven pounds, nine shillings, sterling.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Warrant or Warrants with receipt or receipts of the party or parties named therein shall constitute and be a sufficient authority and acquittance for the payment by the said Receiver General of the sum or sums therein specified, and the said Receiver General shall be allowed credit for the same in his Accounts accordingly.
