MESSAGE from his Excellency the Governor in Chief, by Mr. William Boutillier, Gentleman Usher of the Black Rod;

Mr. Speaker,

I am commanded by his Excellency the Governor in Chief, to acquaint this Honorable House, that it is his Excellency's pleasure, that the Members thereof, do forthwith attend upon him, in the Legislative Council Chamber.

Accordingly, Mr. Speaker and the House went up to attend his Excellency, when his Excellency was pleased to give, in His Majesty's name, the Royal Assent to the following public Bills: viz.

An Act further to continue the Acts therein mentioned for making a temporary provision for the regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or inland navigation.

An Act further to continue for a limited time, an Act passed in the forty-third year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act "for the better preservation of His Majesty's Government, as "by Law happily established in this Province."
