Hun Peril After War

Enemy Will Remain in all the Fundamentals Exactly the Same

(By Archibald Hurd.)
After the war has closed, Germany will remain in all fundamentals the Germany which existed before the war. She will have lost many thousands of her best manhood, but the population of Germany increases at the rate of 800,000 a year. She will be burdened by a great debt, but the Germans have a frugal people and will bend themselves to the task of adjusting the balance. The commercial and industrial congestion, owing to our blockade, but the remedy for the disease will be a policy of "dumping."
